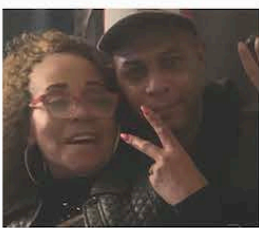
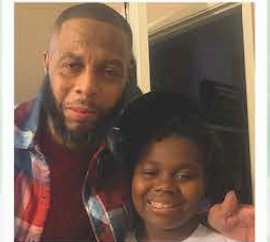
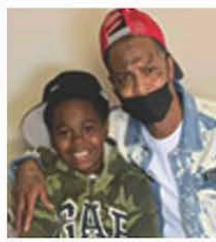
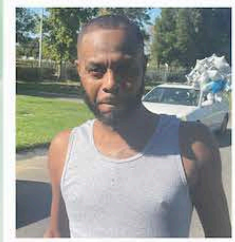
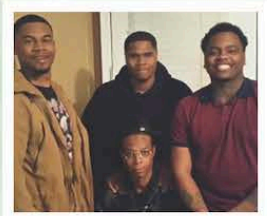
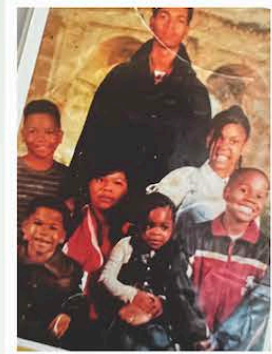
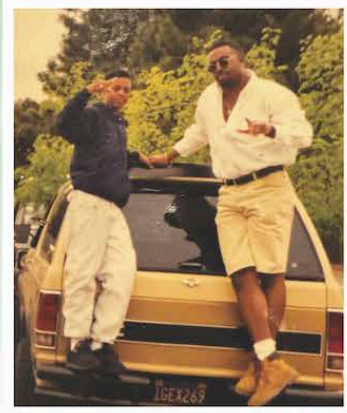
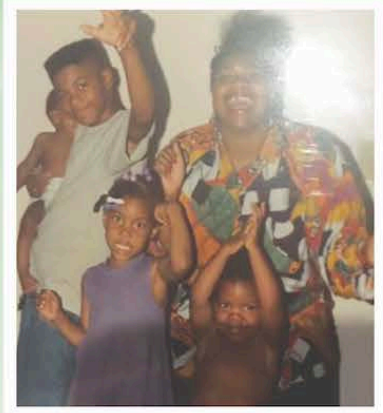
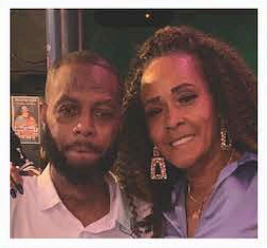


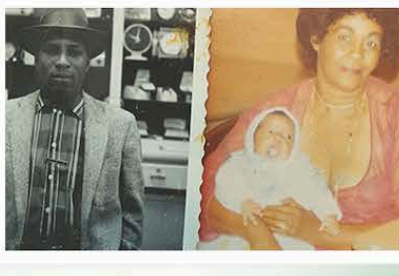
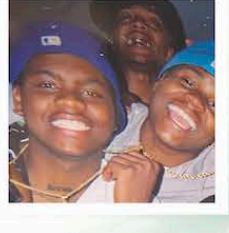
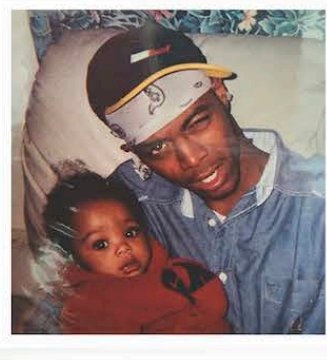
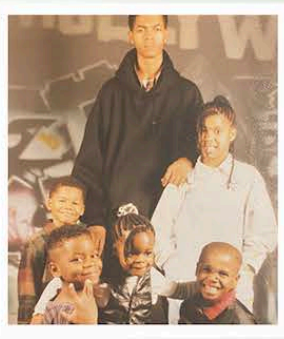
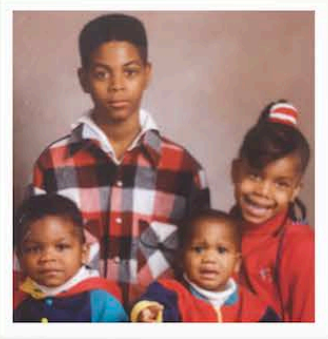


Let Me Go
